Senior Supreme Star: Teen – Elegant divisions



If a Division title or Supreme Star title is not awarded at the pageant, you have the option of joining our Hometown Ambassador program and will have the opportunity to be crowned on stage.


The fee for this title will be covered under your entrance fee to the pageant.

All payments are **non-refundable** and **non-transferable**, regardless of attendance.

Additional Fees:

- Audience wristbands: \$5 each
 - You may pre-purchase wristbands for the day of the pageant and will be available for pickup when you arrive at the pageant.
 - However, wristbands WILL be available for purchase at the door the day of the pageant.

Deadlines

Headshots

Each contestant must submit **one headshot** for the program book.

- Guidelines
 - Must be a clear and crisp professional-style photo
 - NO selfies
 - Pose: Headshot (face forward) or 3/4 turn
 - o Accepted Sizes: 5"x7" or 8"x10"
 - Minor editing allowed (i.e. stray hairs blemishes), but no heavy digital alterations

Attire

Interview style dress or interview suit.
Suit is not necessary and only for older contestants.
Please present a professional, clean appearance.

Timing

Tiny - 1 minute Little - Jr. Teen - 2 minutes Teen - Elegant - 3 minutes

Poise & speaking skills
Personality & eye contact
Confidence & age appropriate
communication

On-Stage Introduction (10%)

This is a short introduction speech including the following items:

Attire

Red, White, & Blue Outfit of Choice (See guidelines below)

Timing

Time limit - 45 seconds

Judges Look For

Confidence Personality Communication skills

Red, White, & Blue Modeling will **immediately** follow the on-stage introduction!

Red, White, & Blue Outfit of Choice Modeling (20%)

This is a **freeform modeling routine** to music, showcasing personality and style in a red, white, and blue-themed outfit. Show us your stuff!

Attire

Anything red, white, & blue themed NO FULL GLITZ, FORMAL GOWNS, OR SWIMSUITS Must be age-appropriate

Timing

Time limit - 45 seconds

Judges Look For

Modeling ability Creativity & personality Stage presence Appropriateness and fit of outfit

Formal Wear & Pop Question (40%)

Contestants will answer an age appropriate, random pop question followed by a formal wear modeling routine.

This modeling routine will follow a slow, T-shaped walking pattern. Please see the next page for the expected walking formation.

Attire

Tiny (3-4 yrs)
T-length or floor length dress,
dress shoes with socks or tights.

Little, Junior, Jr. Teen (5-15 yrs)

Long formal gown with straps. Short dresses may result in deductions.

Teen, Miss, Ms., and Elegant (16+)
Long formal gown. Short dresses may result in deductions.

Timing

Time limit - 45 seconds



Only tips of the shoes should be visible, if any, for the Little-Elegant divisions.

Please check the choice of shoe and heel size for age appropriateness. It is important that you are able to confidently walk in your shoes!

Stage Layout



You will be ushered to X1 where you will stop and pose. As the emcee begins reading about you, walk and stop on X2. At this point, you will be facing head on with the judges. Listen for the emcee to say the key words SHE, HER, or YOUR NAME to continue moving. When you hear a key word, walk to X3. Stop at X3 and model for the judges and audience. When you hear the next key word, walk to X4. Stop and pose at X4. When you hear the next key word walk to and pose at X5. PLEASE WAIT TO BE DISMISSED BY THE EMCEE! This gives the judges time to review your outfit and appropriately score you!

Remember to walk slow, graceful, and fluid! Take your time to show off your beautiful gown and gorgeous smile! It is important to look at ALL the judges as well.

Optional Competitions Information

There are Mini, Junior, & Senior categories for each optional competition

Star Photogenic Competition

- Submit one or more professional-quality headshots 5"x7" or 8"x10". Photos may be color or black and white.
- The photos will be judged on clarity, originality, and personality shown.
- <u>Heavy</u> digital editing is **not** permitted.
- You must have your name and division marked on the back of each picture.

Star Essay Competition

Choose one prompt from the following in your appropriate category

<u>Mini</u> (Tiny - Little Divisions)

- 1. What do you do to be kind?
- 2. Who is someone you've helped?
- 3. How do you show love to family and friends?
- 4. What would you do if you were the "Queen of Kindness"?

<u>Junior</u> (Junior - Jr. Teen Divisions)

- 1. Tell about a way you helped someone at home or school.
- 2. Why do you think helping others is fun and important?
- 3. Who inspires you to be kind and helpful, and why?
- 4. If you could lead a community project, what would it be?

<u>Senior</u> (Teen - Elegant Divisions)

- 1. What role does service play in defining a true leader?
- 2. How have your personal experiences shaped your passion for giving back?
- 3. In what ways can pageantry promote social responsibility and volunteerism?
- 4. What legacy do you want to leave as a titleholder?
- Judges will be looking for content, neatness, age-appropriate writing, grammar, and punctuation.
- Age guidelines -
 - Mini: may draw a picture and/or dictate to an adult
 - o Junior: ½ to 1 page **typed** response
 - Senior: 1 ½ to 2 pages **typed** response

Star Poster Competition

- Design a poster promoting:
 - Community service
 - Helping others
 - o A cause important to you
- Must be on 20x30 foam core board (deductions may occur if not followed)
- Mixed media is encouraged (markers, crayons, magazines, photos, etc.)
- Slight 3D elements are okay, but <u>cannot extend more than 3/4" off surface</u>.
 - NO overhang or oversized posters allowed.
- Judges will be looking for creativity, age-appropriate design, and clarity of message.
- You must have your name and division on the back of your poster.

Star Poster submission must be brought the day of the pageant - November 16, 2025!

ARSP Pageant Day Rules and Regulations

American Royal Spirit Pageants (ARSP)

Your age division is determined as of **November 1** of the pageant year.

1. **Deposits are non-refundable** but may be transferred to other ARSP pageants or to the Community Ambassador Program.

- 2. The pageant system and staff are **not responsible** for accidents, injuries, or loss of property. Keep all valuables with you.
- 3. **No video or cameras** are allowed in the theater. Professional photographers are available. You may take photos in the **main lobby only**, provided you do not interfere with photographers. Do **not** use their backdrops. **Absolutely No photography in dressing areas.**
- 4. No smoking or alcohol is permitted at any time.
- 5. All participants give permission for use of photos for advertising and onsite purposes.
- 6. Queens and Princesses **must stay after the pageant** for photos used on the ARSP websites and in future materials.
- 7. Contestants **must be available the entire day** of the pageant for rehearsals and information.
- 8. **Do not ask the judges** for their opinions.
- 9. **No males are allowed** in the dressing rooms at any time. If needed, an ARSP Queen or staff member will assist in retrieving someone.
- 10. One dresser is allowed per contestant under age 12. Their name must be submitted to the coordinator. **Mothers should not serve as the dresser,** but may assist younger children if necessary.
- 11. We move at a **fast pace**. Contestants not present for rehearsals or competitions without permission may be disqualified. Please inform staff of your location at all times.
- 12. No running, yelling, or loud talking in the theater or halls. This disrupts those competing onstage.
- 13. All contestants, guests, and family must display **respectful**, **appropriate behavior** at all times. **Negative behavior will not be tolerated** and may lead to disqualification.
- 14. Contestants should always **dress and act appropriately**. Judges may be in hallways and other areas. Keep a **positive attitude** throughout the event.
- 15. No other Queen titles are allowed in dressing or preparation areas unless designated as ARSP workers.
- 16. Do not wear titles from other pageant systems at any ARSP event (see director for exceptions).
- 17. **No solicitation** for other pageant systems is allowed during ARSP events. This may lead to **loss of title or disciplinary action**.
- 18. If a contestant must **relinquish a title within 90 days** of winning (due to another pageant system), the **next highest score** will be promoted. All awarded items (crown, sash, trophy, etc.) must be returned in excellent condition or a **\$100 fee** will be required for replacements.
- 19. STATE TITLEHOLDERS: To strengthen the ARSP system, all state titleholders are expected to compete at Nationals. A coupon will be included in the prize package to offset some costs. Non-participation at Nationals means ineligibility for an RAS crown at the end of your reign.

ARSP Ambassador Program Rules and Regulations

American Royal Spirit Pageants (ARSP)

- 1. Queens and Ambassadors must always **dress appropriately** for appearances and events. When wearing your crown and sash, your behavior and appearance reflect on the entire organization.
- 2. **Jeans are not allowed** with crown and sash unless you have express permission from the director.
- 3. **Plastic or rubber flip flops** are not allowed when wearing your crown and sash due to safety concerns.
- 4. **No smoking or alcohol consumption** is allowed at events or while wearing the crown and sash.
- 5. **Inappropriate behavior** (swearing, bullying, name-calling, lying, cheating) is not tolerated in person, writing, or on social media. This applies to titleholders, families, chaperones, and visitors. Violations may result in **loss of title**.
- 6. Follow the **dress code** for each event. When uncertain, wear the red ARSP shirt with black or white bottoms depending on the season. Formal wear should be worn when specified. Dress code will always be determined by the director for each event. If not sure you can contact the event coordinator or the Director.
- 7. Maintain a **clean and polished appearance**. Limit earrings and refrain from wearing inappropriate body jewelry when wearing a crown and sash. If you have questions, please contact the director.
- 8. If you need to replace your crown due to the crown being lost or damaged; Sash due to loss or damage. There will be a **fee to have them replaced** at the current purchase price.
- 9. All titleholders give permission for **event photos to be used** on the website and in promotional materials.
- 10. **Be present for group photos** to ensure all representatives are recognized.
- 11. **Ultimate, Supreme, Division Queens and Princesses** must complete **12 community service events** per year. Parades/festivals count as ½ an event unless working. Failure to complete this may result in forfeiture of prize money.
- 12. **Royal and Community Ambassador Supremes** must complete **6 events** per year to maintain good standing.
- 13. **Speak to the director before planning any event.** She will provide approval, guidelines, dress codes, and chaperone info.
- 14. **RSVP to all invitations** from ARSP or fellow members. Most communication is conducted through Facebook Messenger; please get in touch with the director if an alternative method is required.
- 15. Some events may have **age restrictions**. If you need more age-appropriate options, work with the director to create new events that cater to your needs.
- 16. Do **not gossip or speak negatively** about the program. Concerns should be brought directly to the director.
- 17. If a complaint is made against a member, it will be **reviewed thoroughly**, and appropriate action will be taken.
- 18. No wearing of other pageant titles at ARSP events unless approved by the director.
- 19. **No promotion or solicitation** of other pageant systems at ARSP events. This may result in disciplinary action or forfeiture of the title.
- 20. Do not use ARSP contact lists or events to promote outside organizations.
- 21. Titleholders are expected to **fulfill their full reign**. Competing in another system during your reign is highly discouraged. Attendance is required at the next pageant to crown your successor.

- 22. If you must **relinquish your title within 90 days** due to another pageant, the next-highest scoring contestant will be promoted. Crown, sash, and prizes must be returned in excellent condition or replaced at a **\$100 fee**.
- 23. **STATE TITLEHOLDERS** must compete at the **National Pageant**. A coupon will be provided in your prize package. Not competing makes you ineligible for an RAS crown.
- 24. Any returned checks or closed accounts will be charged a \$35.00 fee.
- 25. Titleholders must maintain **clear and open communication** with the director.
- 26. Titleholders may purchase **magnetic car signs** or use the standard ones provided (which must be returned the same day)—no **handmade signs** allowed.
- 27. The crown and sash represent **empowerment and service**. ARSP members make a difference in their communities and should take pride in their role.
- 28. Annual dues of \$45.00 must be paid by pageant day or no later than **December 31** of the same year. Failure to pay will place you in **inactive status**.
